

Phase II Development Begins at Garden of Remembrance



Four new Forest Glade areas and over 1,000 new plots are now available for purchase.

Phase II development has begun at the Garden of Remembrance as planned and on schedule, providing yet another testament to the foresight of Washington Hebrew Congregation and the region-wide acceptance of the Garden of Remembrance as the cemetery of choice for the greater Washington Jewish community.

Comprising several acres in the northeast quadrant of the Memorial Park, the area now under development will accommodate additional partner congregations and those unaffiliated with a congregation. Phase II offers 1,000 plots and four new 20-plot Forest Glade areas adjacent to permanently protected woodland. The Forest Glade areas in the initial section of the Garden of Remembrance were among the first to be purchased when the Park first opened, mainly by families who are providing for generations to come.

The Garden of Remembrance is the region's only not-for-profit cemetery operated by a board of Jewish community leaders and open to members of all congregations as well as those unaffiliated with a congregation.
